The Liturgy of the Sacrament

The following prayer is said over the gifts:

Blessed art thou, Lord God of all creation:
through thy goodness we have this bread to offer,
which earth has given and human hands have made.
It will become for us the Bread of Life.
Blessed be God for ever.

Blessed art thou, Lord God of all creation:
through thy goodness we have this wine to offer,
fruit of the vine and work of human hands.
It will become for us the Cup of Salvation.
Blessed be God for ever.

The Priest turns to the congregation:

Pray, my brothers and sisters,
that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God the
almighty Father.

May the Lord accept the sacrifice at thy hands for
the praise and glory of his name,
for our good and the good of all his Church.

Please stand.

THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

The Lord be with you
and with thy spirit.

Lift up your hearts.

We lift them up unto the Lord.

Let us give thanks unto the Lord our God.

It is meet and right so to do.

It is very meet, right and our bounden duty that we should,
at all times and in all places, give thanks unto thee,

O Lord, holy Father, almighty, everlasting God,
through Jesus Christ, thine only Son, our Lord.

For he is thy living Word; through him thou hast created all
things from the beginning,
and fashioned us in thine own image.

Through him thou didst redeem us from the slavery of sin,
giving him to be born of a woman,
to die upon the cross, and to rise again for us.

Through him thou hast made us a people for thine own
possession, exalting him to thy right hand on high,

and unite us in the body of thy Son, Jesus Christ our Lord,

by whom, and with whom, and in whom, in the unity of the
Holy Spirit, all honour and glory be unto thee,
O Father almighty, world without end.

Amen.

THE COMMUNION

The Celebrant elevates the bread and the wine and says:

world.

Blessed are those who are called to his supper.

shall be healed.**

*All communicants of good standing in their own Church, of any
denomination, are invited to receive Holy Communion. Those
who do not wish to receive the Sacrament are invited to come to
the altar rail for a blessing, keeping their heads bowed as an
indication to the ministers.*

POST COMMUNION PRAYER
